3rd Annual USA Jama'at Public Relations Seminar @ Bait-uz-Zafar

The Third Annual Public Relations seminar was held on February 28, 2009 in Bait-uz-Zafar. It was a 2 day event. The seminar was organized to bring public relations and chapter presidents or their representatives from all branches (69) in the United States to discuss matters requiring national efforts and organization. 110 Jama'at members from across the nation attended the two day seminar. This includes 85 Khuddam, Ansar and 25 Lajna. Specific recommendations were made to the PR department were to engage the new administration of Barack Obama with the views of the Ahmadiyya Community given the renewed policy of diplomacy and understanding / reasoning with the Muslim community as a whole. Daud Haneef sahib, Missionary USA in charge also took part in this event. Zinda Bajwa sahib outlined the importance of complying with the direction set forth by Khalifatul Messih V and provided examples of such instructions by Hazoor over the past years playing an important role in the guidance of the PR department activities.

Peace Through Religion Conference

Following the 2009 Public Relation Seminar on the 28th February The all important Peace through religion conference was held on Sunday March 1, 2009, at Bait-uz-Zafar NY. Five distinguished speakers, who hail from various positions of life, were the key feature of this significant program of Peace through religion.

As the hallmark of our each and every activity is to begin with raising God's name the conference was declared open with the recitation of Holy Quran by Hafiz Samiullah sahib.

First speaker Mr. Arif Humayun threw light on the radicalization of Islam and how Islam got politicized and began to decline to-

wards the start of the Renaissance and that whatever Islam had brought to the world was slowly being destroyed by those who called themselves Muslims due their gross error in understanding and practicing Islam. With the help of a slide show well prepared, he made it conspicuous that how the persecution against Ahmadies began and the motives behind it, made a national assembly to decide about a faith and thus the fate of a Muslim community. Mr. Humayun based his presentation on some top notch writers intellectual's writings.

Then came Rabbi Moshe Ulmer of Conservative Synagogue of Fresh Meadows who spoke about dialogue. That if there is no dialogue nothing can be solved in this world. He also mentioned how Pres Anwar Sadat of Egypt was the first Arab head of state to make efforts and visited Israel to make peace with Israel. He stated that the turmoil in world is due to falsehood and if the truth is practiced peace is achievable.

State Assemblyman Mark Weprin spoke about how the area he represents is made of such diverse religious and racial backgrounds that the children of different backgrounds are taught to hold hands together when they assemble and that they don't care about what each other believe in or what they look like. He further stated that ignorance about another person and group is the cause of hatred, when you don't sit with others you don't know about them and then you assume things.

Imam Daud Hanif Sahib also spoke about religion through peace, he said that God Almighty Has clearly given the directions to follow, and joining each other in good

deeds, regardless of your color creed and belief. He said like Jews we too have firm faith that the peace is in God and with God. Imam Hanif quoted the last sermon of Prophet peace be upon him.

State Senator Frank Padavan also spoke of the diversity that this area represents and the philosophy of peace that the Jama'at upholds, he at the outset quoted the famous Frank Sinatra's line "If you can make it there, you can make it anywhere, It's up to you, New York." And that meant that if the NY Bait-uz-Zafar is making such efforts of unification through dialogue the Ahmadiyya community can make it happen in the whole world.

With that Mr. Asad Bajwa the moderator for the day, thanked the participants. Almost all PR partakers with other outside Jama'at guests were served tasty lunch cooked by Mr. Mansoor Ahmad Secretary Ziafat and his efficient team. Soon after that Zuhr and Asr prayers were offered, to call it a day.
